confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-51496. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LITTLE RIVER AND GREENMAN CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF NORTH UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 1.9 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 0.8 ACRES, AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.049 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.034 CFS FROM LITTLE RIVER FOR IRRIGATION OF 1.9 ACRES, 0.01 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION FROM GREENMAN CREEK, AND 0.005 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE FROM GREENMAN CREEK

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 16, 1989

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
