CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 3.77 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 3.77 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits S-1216 and S-26001. The priority dates are 3/25/1912, for Irrigation and 1/16/1959, for Supplemental Irrigation. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.143 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.048 cfs for IRRIGATION and 0.095 cfs for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or their equivalents in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cfs per acre for IRRIGATION, and is limited to 0.0375 cfs (3/80) per acre for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


