CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

12 H, INC C/O TYLER HANSELL 75858 COLONEL JORDAN RD HERMISTON OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1, 2, 3, AND 4, AND NEW WELL 4 in the UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION of 64.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under the terms of Permit G-100. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 26, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.81 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which they are entitled.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation (Wells 2, 3, 4, and New Well 4), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 1).

Water shall be acquired from the same alluvial aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 2020, at Special Order Volume 116, Page 937, approving Transfer Application T-13164, supersedes Certificate 68709, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
