## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS for IRRIGATION of 101.1 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 705.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under the terms of Permit G-10651. The date of priority is AUGUST 12, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 6.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring ling, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (New Well 4), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 2).

Water shall be acquired from the same alluvial aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 2020, at Special Order Volume 116, Page 937, approving Transfer Application T-13164, supersedes Certificate 82599, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
