confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in. Volume 1 and Volume 5, at Page 252 and Page 397.

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 2.15 ACRES OF TRACT #4

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31, OF EACH YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1908

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain and operate a headgate, an inline flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen or fish by-pass device as approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 18, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 465, approving Transfer Application T-8471, supersedes Certificate 7139, State record of Water Right Certificates.
