confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9063. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS, TRIBUTARY OF FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 16.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 2, 1980

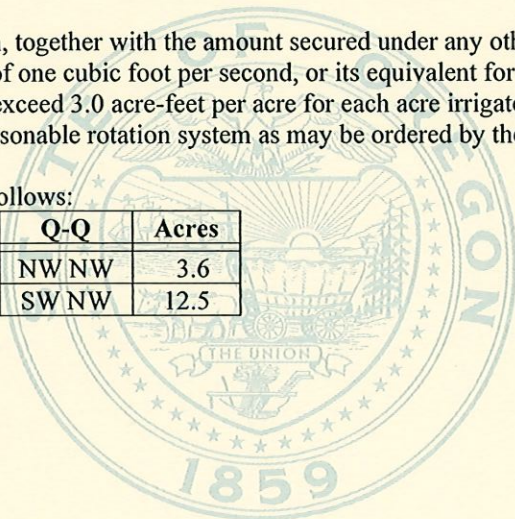
The wells are located as follows:

26 S	17 E	WM	32	SW NE	WELL #1 - 1300 FEET NORTH AND 2640 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32
26 S	17 E	WM	32	SE NE	WELL #2 - 1242 FEET NORTH AND 63 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:


The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 16, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 324, approving Transfer Application T-9057, and together with Certificate 80659, supersedes Certificate 53349, State record of Water Right Certificates.
