CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 116.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit No. S-27713. The dates of priority are NOVEMBER 6, 1961 for 0.01 cubic foot per second, and JANUARY 8, 1962 for 1.13 cubic feet per second. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.14 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3330, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


Prior to October 1, 2025, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 11 2024, approving Transfer Application T- 14349, and supersedes Certificate 33882, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
