CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KRAEMER FARMS
9777 S WILDCAT ROAD
MOLALLA, OR 97038

confirms the right to use the waters of the STETSON WELL in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 21.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11688. The date of priority is JUNE 19, 1990. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The irrigation season under this right is limited to March 1 through October 31 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in additional point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 30 2024, at Special Order Volume 131, Page 187, and together with Certificate 93831, supersedes Certificate 91580 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
