CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the GOOSE LAKE BASIN for the purpose of  
IRRIGATING 59.23 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9659. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1981. The right is  
limited to not more than 0.74 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured  
at the well.

The well is located as follows:

41 S	18 E	WM	13	NW NE	150 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM THE S1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right  
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre,  
or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0  
acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


