The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). Water use measurement conditions:


- a. The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device in good working order at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 18, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 639, approving Transfer Application T-12190, as further modified by a final order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 15, 2023, at Special Order Volume 127, Page 1007, reverting a portion of the right and together with Certificate 96968 supersedes Certificate 30205, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
