and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 471; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 5.26 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of retation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.
