CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GOLDEN RULE FARMS, INC.
PO BOX 255
CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OR 97641

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1, a tributary of SILVER CREEK (SILVER LAKE) for IRRIGATION of 11.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2165. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

27 S	17 E	WM	27	NE SW	2740 FEET SOUTH AND 2700 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The pump system shall include an in-line flow meter, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;


The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 82619, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 08 2025, approving Transfer Application T-13162.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
