confirms the right to use the A WELL IN UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

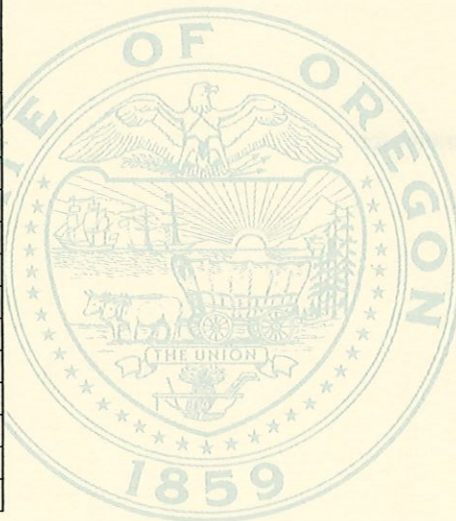
This right was perfected under the terms of Permit G-6831. The date of priority is MAY 24, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 8.3 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.


The water user shall maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This right is subject to existing rights.

This certificate is issued for partial perfection of Permit G-6831 as described in OAR 690-320-0040 and by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 14, 2024 at Special Order Volume 131, Pages 282-283.
