NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (from cert 39755) described as follows:

The water user shall maintain, in good working order, the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 15, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 103, approving Transfer Application 11527, supercedes Certificate 82456, State record of Water Right Certificates.
