confirms the right to use the waters of the MILL CREEK RACE, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, to maintain an instream flow for public use.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 543A.305 based on the conversion of Hydroelectric License HE 251 to an instream water right.

The date of priority is DECEMBER 7, 1977.

The instream water right is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any authorized appropriation of water from this source for domestic, municipal, irrigation or any other beneficial consumptive use, or for storage for such purposes, that was made prior to OCTOBER 29, 2001.

The right is limited to not more than 50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

This right is for flows to be maintained in MILL CREEK RACE at the site of the former point of diversion under HE 251 located within the SW ¼ NE ¼ of Section 26, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W.M., Marion County.

Hydroelectric license HE 251 is terminated. This Water Right Certificate supersedes Hydroelectric License HE 251.
