confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-4375. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WALLOWA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF GRANDE RONDE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 40.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 5, 1919

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
1 N	42 E	WM	3	SE SW	1050 FEET NORTH AND 1580 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 3

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state office.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report all flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 28, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 717, approving Transfer Application T-7473, supercedes Certificate 8701, State record of Water Right Certificates.
