CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-6051. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELLS 2, 3 AND 4 IN THE SILVER LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 101.57 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.27 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.97 CFS FROM WELL 4 AND 1.27 CFS FROM WELLS 2 AND 3, IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TO EXCEED 1.27 CFS

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 5, 1974

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The portion of this right for supplemental irrigation is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Well 4), together with that diverted at Wells 2 and Well 3, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 13) described as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each new point of appropriation.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The additional well shall be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of 100 feet below land surface.

The well at the new point of appropriation shall be maintained to the well construction standards in effect as of May 10, 1991, and must include an access port.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 12, 2015, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 572, approving Transfer Application T-11912, and together with Certificate 91057, supercedes Certificate 76042, State record of Water Right Certificates.
