CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAN AND HEATHER COFFEL  
1061 WESTSIDE RD  
CAMAS VALLEY, OR 97416

confirms the right to use the waters of the MIDDLE FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 27.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13989. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-ONE-THOUSANDTH (1/1000) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.5 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume of 13.9 acre-feet, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes Certificate 14664, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 22 2024, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-112. This Certificate, together with Certificate 97929 and the applicant's portion of conserved water under CW-112, supersedes Certificate 14664.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
