NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The measuring device shall be located in the ditch below the point where the inflow of both the existing point of diversion and the additional point of diversion enter the ditch.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the additional point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of water for the purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands and place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 17, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 168, approving Transfer Application T-10555, supercedes Certificate 48411, State record of Water Right Certificates.
