CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

3/4 CIRCLE A RANCH
84221 FRED ASHLEY RD
TYGH VALLEY OR 97063

confirms the right to use the waters of the WHITE RIVER, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 201.83 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 196. The dates of priority are 1874 for 0.29 cfs and 1904 for the balance necessary to make up a total amount which said lands are entitled as designated below*

The amount of water to which this right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually used beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per each acre irrigated during any irrigation season (with further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree); if available at the original point of diversion; NW¼ SE¼, Sec. 10, T 4 S, R13 E, W.M., French Estate and Knighten Ditch (listed as Anderson Ditch in adjudication proceedings) - 890 Feet South and 1680 Feet West from the E¼ of Section 10.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

(*NOTE: original right – the date of 1874 is for 0.32 cubic foot per second of water, to be used on any of the lands herein described. All of the water used for the balance of the land shall take the date of 1904.)

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device to measure the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the waster for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 12, 2009, at Special Order Volume 75, Page 61, approving Transfer Application T-10239, and together with Certificate 84128, supersedes Certificate 48410, State record of Water Right Certificates.
