CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That HARTLEY & EDGINGTON of Sisters State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek, tributary of the Deschutes River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 18 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 471 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1906 for the irrigation of Tract No. 1 and from 1905 for the irrigation of Tract No. 2 as herein set forth:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose , and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second as of date 1906 and 0.27 cubic foot per second as of date 1905, or the equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

4 1/2 acres in Tract No. 1: 2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 2 1/2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty (20), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian.

13 1/2 acres in Tract No. 2: 6 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty (20), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
