CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MICHAEL W. MATTIS
FORT ROCK, OREGON 97735

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 55.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-10227. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 2, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.695 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


