CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

O. E. FARNSWORTH
HEPPNER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER, in Gilliam County, Oregon, for IRRIGATION of 7.2 ACRES (during the irrigation season).

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
