CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CRABTREE CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH FORK SANTIAM RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-10519. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1932. The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.063 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
