CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES B. and JENNIFER DARBY
1898 NW SUNVIEW PLACE
GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of JIMMY CREEK, a tributary to the ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 504. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.042 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1/142 (0.007) of one cubic foot per second for each acre of land irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.96 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to an annual volume limitation of 17.8 acre feet.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The Applicant shall install a weir or flume at PODs 1 and 2, or suitable measuring devices with prior approval of the Director.


The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the point of diversion located in the NESW of Section 17 consistent with ODFW's operation and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly and is unsuccessful in working the with water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 93296, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 21 2024, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-125. This certificate together with the conserved water under CW-125 supersedes Certificate 93296.
