CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALTER L. CROSIER
RT. 2, BOX 1385
ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE for FOUR FAMILIES and IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37976. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1973. The amount of water to which such right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.034 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.01 cfs for DOMESTIC and 0.024 for IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 45888, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **OCT 21 2024**, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-88, recorded at Special Order Volume 133, Page 236. This certificate, together with Certificates 98058 and 98059 and the conserved water under CW-88, supersedes Certificate 45888, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
