CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37976. The priority date is APRIL 13, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND March 1 to October 31 and shall be further limited to an annual volume of 1.71 acre-feet.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion at approximately River Mile (RM) 4.0:

To the confluence with the South Umpqua River.


The instream right established by this Allocation of Conserved Water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 45888, and any related decree.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 133, Page 2316, approving Conserved Water Application CW-88. This Certificate together with Certificates 98057 and 98058 and the conserved water under CW-88 supersedes Certificate 45888, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
