CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 28.0 ACRES and that said right has been confirmed by decree of Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1869;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from APRIL 1st to OCTOBER 1st of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 17190, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 0 8 2025 finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-142, recorded at Special Order Volume 133, Page 1038. This certificate, together with Certificates 98122, 98127, and the conserved water under CW-142, supersedes Certificate 17190, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
