CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELIZABETH M SARTHOU, TRUSTEE

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER,
for IRRIGATION of 6.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3727. The date of priority is MARCH 7, 1918. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.085 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-SEVENTY EIGHTIETH AND EIGHT TENTHS (1/78.8) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation of 26.8 acre-feet per year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 83471, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 8, 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-142, recorded in Special Order Volume 133, Page 1638. This Certificate together with Certificate 98124 and the conserved water under CW-142 supersedes Certificate 83471, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
