CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 196.

SOURCE OF WATER: TYGH CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WHITE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1889

The points of diversion are located as follows:

3 S	12 E	WM	25	NW SW	ORIGINAL POD - 70 FEET SOUTH AND 90 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25
3 S	12 E	WM	25	NW SW	ADDITIONAL POD - 610 FEET SOUTH AND 450 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25

That the amount to which such right is entitled, for the purposes of aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree).

A description of the place of use is as follows:

3 S	12 E	WM	25	NW SW	7.3
3 S	12 E	WM	25	SW SW	0.7

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.



It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 20, 1983, at Special Order Volume 37, Page 406, approving Transfer Application T-5275, supercedes Certificate 46637, State record of Water Right Certificates.
