CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS J. AND WARREN T. HARPER

JUNCTION CITY, OR 97448

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS No. 4 and No. 5, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 17.15 ACRES and OPERATION of PEPPERMINT DISTILLERY.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6631. The date of priority is JANUARY 5, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.21 cfs from Well No. 5 for irrigation and 0.20 cfs from Well No. 4 for distillery, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


DISTILLERY – WELL NO. 4
