confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1.

PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL USES

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Notwithstanding ORS 536.750 (1) (c), which would allow a junior water right holder to be granted a preference for water use for human consumption or livestock watering after a declaration of drought, the water user shall subordinate water use under this right to any water right with a priority date of 1874 or earlier.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described and said right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree. Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 30, 2003, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 980, approving Transfer Application T-8255, supersedes Certificate 6538, State record of Water Right Certificates.
