CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-5042. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF WOODS CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF PUDDING RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 117.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.46 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.64 CFS FROM WELL NO. 1, 0.82 CFS FROM WELL NO. 2, AND 1.46 CFS FROM WELL NO. 3, OR ANY COMBINATION NOT TOTALING MORE THAN 1.46 CFS

DATE OF PRIORITY: NOVEMBER 23, 1970

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well No. 3), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 31, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 402, approving Transfer Application T-12445, and together with Certificate 93280, supercedes Certificate 44105, State record of Water Right Certificates.
