confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION of 18.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3517. The date of priority is AUGUST 30, 1917. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place of use where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion located as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain the fish screens as approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 12, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 21, approving Transfer Application T-6656, and together with Certificates 76674 and 98161 (REVERSION CERTIFICATE), supersedes Certificate 2428, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
