CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FORREST J. HORTON
RT 4 BOX 210
HILLSBORO, OR 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of MCFEE CREEK and RESERVOIR constructed under Application No. R-47873, Permit No. R-5686, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.4 ACRES AND FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35370. The date of priority is AUGUST 4, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.08 CFS from the creek for irrigation and 0.01 CFS from creek and reservoir for fish culture, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The reservoir location is located as follows:

2 S	3 W	WM	14	NE NW	840 FEET SOUTH AND 100 FEET WEST FROM THE N1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5686.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board
