CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-43640. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: DEEP LAKE, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 73.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.92 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 10, 1977

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

The well from which water is taken under the right shall be constructed so that the use of the well will affect the surface water source similarly to the use of the original authorized point of diversion.

The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the purpose is restricted to the beneficial use on the lands and place of use described. The right is subject to the minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION FROM SURFACE WATER TO GROUND WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 21, 2009, at Special Order Volume 77, Page 915, approving Transfer Application T-10602, supercedes Certificate 61435, State record of Water Right Certificates.
