The right is limited to not more than ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.
