CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SIMON JUANTO  
LAKEVIEW, OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of the THOMAS CREEK for IRRIGATION of 81.08 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 233. The date of priority is 1879.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-fourth acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, and one-half acre foot per acre during any 30-day period after June 1<sup>st</sup>, of each year; and two and one-half acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH of a second foot per acre.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 5245, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 02 2025, approving Transfer Application T-13731.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
