CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-51461. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: S-71812

SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM AND STOLK RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-71811, PERMIT R-11458, TRIBUTARIES OF ASH SWALE

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.051 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: WATER MAY BE APPROPRIATED FROM LIVE FLOW ONLY FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH APRIL 30 OF EACH YEAR. STORED WATER MAY BE USED AT ANY TIME DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON.

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 27, 1991

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be maintained and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
