confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127.

SOURCE OF WATER: BIRCH CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF UMATILLA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 47.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1873 FOR 7.85 ACRES, 1889 FOR 7.85 ACRES, AND 1900 FOR 31.3 ACRES

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

Water use measurement conditions:


- a) The water user shall maintain and operate a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion.
- b) The water user shall allow the water master access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to use water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECT A SCRIVENER'S ERROR REGARDING THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE NUMBER AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 98154.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 13, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 993, approving Transfer Application T-10311, and together with Certificate 87012, supersedes Certificate 56171, State record of Water Right Certificates.
