## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 13.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-40004. The date of priority is APRIL 16, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.



The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 29, 2005, at Special Order Volume 65, Page 241, approving Transfer Application T-8997, and together with Certificate 81519, supersedes a portion of Certificate 75605, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
