CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SILVER CREEK DITCH COMPANY
ENTERPRISE, OR 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of SILVER CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 244.07 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2749 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 434, on the 19th day of April, 1922. The date of priority is DECEMBER 6, 1915. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.05 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


