CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-6696. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL, A TRIBUTARY OF FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 34.91 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 6, 1975

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meter or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 5, 2010, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 20, approving Transfer Application 10949, and together with Certificate 86683, supercedes Certificate 47618, State record of Water Right Certificates.
