CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That JACOB N. QUIBERG  
of Sisters State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Squaw Creek, tributary of the Deschutes River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 103 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of  
Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,  
in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at  
page 471 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the  
purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-  
pose, and shall not exceed 2.06 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case  
of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system  
ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water  
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water  
is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

40 1/2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 1/2 acres in  
the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 14 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of  
Southeast quarter; 7 1/2 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of  
Section Eight (8), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Ten (10) East of Willamette  
Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.
