## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9020. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELL 1 IN FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 11, 1980

The well is located as follows:

27 S	19 E	WM	8	NE NW	1319.99 FEET SOUTH AND 1305.75 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter, or another suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (Well 2), described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 20, 2022, at Special Order Volume 125, Page 720, approving Transfer Application 13865, and together with Certificate 96305, supercedes Certificate 76468, State record of Water Right Certificates.
