CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

F. R. BARON
ROUTE #2, BOX 44
NEWBERG, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APP. R-25198, PER. NO. R-1298, a tributary of ALLEN CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20962. The date of priority is December 14, 1951. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1298. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 21586 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 134, Page 272 approving a partial cancellation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 21586.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
