## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAMSAC LAND LLC  
1446 DELAWARE AVE  
WEST SAINT PAUL MN 55118

confirms the right to use the waters of MURRAY WELL in the WILLAMETTE BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 32.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10852. The date of priority is MARCH 30, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 43.81 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The quantity of water allowed for supplemental irrigation use under this right, together with any other right existing for the same lands, shall not exceed a rate of diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of March 1 to October 31 of each year.

This right is limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others. If use of water under this right is found to interfere with appropriation of water from Paul D. Daily's irrigation well (35/1W-33 aad), use of the Murray Well under this right shall be regulated so as to eliminate the interference.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

This right is for the beneficial use of water.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to the use of the water for the purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 23, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 131, approving Transfer Application T-11505, and together with Certificate 89974, supersedes Certificate 84230, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
