CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-13307. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: ROUGH AND READY CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF WEST FORK ILLINOIS, A TRIBUTARY OF ILLINOIS RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 3, 1938

The point of diversion is located as follows:

40 S	9 W	WM	14	NE SW	2140 FEET NORTH AND 650 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order, at each point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

The right to the use of water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 22, 2022, at Special Order Volume 125, Page 275, approving Transfer Application T-13590, and together with Certificate 96199, supercedes Certificate 14632, State record of Water Right Certificates.
