CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G. W. BURT
ROSEBURG, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 15.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5857. The date of priority is APRIL 17, 1923. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.080 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE ONE-HUNDRED EIGHTIETH-FIFTH (1/185) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.59 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation 38.88 acre-feet per year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 3, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 518, and together with Certificate 94444, supersedes Certificate 5033, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
