CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 113.

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION; (FROM APRIL 1ST TO SEPTEMBER 20TH OF EACH YEAR)

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1881

The point of diversion is located as follows:

That the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order, at each new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) may require the water user to install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion within one year after receiving written notification that a fish screen is required. Once installed the water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen at the new point of diversion according to ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 22, 2022, at Special Order Volume 125, Page 748, approving Transfer Application T-13526, supercedes Certificate 23, State record of Water Right Certificates.
